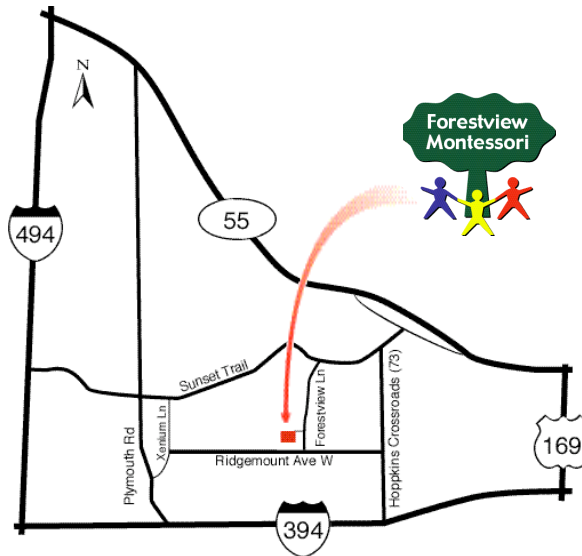

Program Options

Preschool: Children 33 months to 6 years of age enjoy all of the benefits of our carefully prepared Montessori learning environment. Children may work either individually or in small groups, learning from and sharing with one another.

Toddler: Children ages 16 to 33 months. In this program toddlers learn basic skills in preparation for a smooth transition to our preschool program.

Children learn and grow at Forestview Montessori

Science

Children explore the wonders of nature through presentations and hands-on activities involving plants, animals and minerals.

Music

Presentations of musical instruments and listening to music from around the world are integrated into the daily schedule.

Annual Events

A trip to Homestead Apple Orchard, Forestview Fall Festival, a potluck feast at Thanksgiving and an end of the year Holiday Celebration help develop a sense of community.

Math

Children become aware of quantities and develop an early interest in numbers.

Free Play
